Pipeline Record Amendments in the City of Edmonton Licence 9417 Proceeding 24221 Application 24221-A001

Record amendment application

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (ATCO), by Application 24221-A001 registered on January 10, 2019, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to amend the "wall thickness" of lines 15 and 17 from 0.00 millimetres to 6.35 millimetres in the city of Edmonton.
- 2. The proposed amendments relate to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 9417.
- 3. ATCO stated that lines 15 and 17 of Licence 9417 were originally licensed in 1977 with a "wall thickness" of 6.35 millimetres. Licence amendments were made in numerous locations on Licence 9417 in which the lines had their wall thickness changed incorrectly. To correct the error, Licence 9417 would be amended to indicate the wall thickness of lines 15 and 17 in accordance with the original licence.
- 4. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendments. Since the record amendments do not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 5. Based upon the information provided, the Commission is satisfied that the proposal is of a minor nature, no person will be directly and adversely affected by the proposal and no significant adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendments.

6. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
