Record amendment application

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1610875 registered on September 25, 2014, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the abandonment of lines 5, 15, 16, 17 and 19 in Township 52, Range 24 West of the Fourth Meridian. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 20954.

ATCO stated that the removal work required to properly abandon these lines approved under Application No. 1609614 and Application No. 1610213 had to be completed at separate times in order to accommodate requests from the City of Edmonton, and Alberta Culture requirements. This application was filed as a self-disclosure application, because more than 90 days had elapsed since the first segments of these lines were abandoned.

ATCO stated that lines 5, 15, 16, 17 and 19 were abandoned with all above ground facilities removed in 2014. The pipelines were purged and filled with air. Abandonment tags were added to the abandoned pipelines as per AUC requirements.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
