ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. By Letter L-40-14 dated July 17, 2014, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) accepted the FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) 2014/15 Annual Contracting Plan (ACP);
- B. On April 14, 2015, FEI filed with the Commission an application for approval to amend the Avista Corporation (Avista) Deferred Exchange Agreement (DE1) 2-Year Firm Gas Storage Agreement to extend the term a further 5 years (the Agreement);
- C. FEI requests that the filing and associated documents remain confidential due to their commercially sensitive nature;
- D. By Order G-130-06 dated October 27, 2006, the Commission approved the Rules for Natural Gas Energy Supply Contracts (Rules). The Rules are intended to facilitate the Commission's review of natural gas energy supply contracts pursuant to section 71 of the *Utilities Commission Act*; and
- E. The Commission reviewed the filing and is satisfied that the Agreement between FEI and Avista is consistent with the ACP, is in the public interest, and that the filing and associated documents should be kept confidential.
