ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On November 24, 2015, FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) applied to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) for acceptance of an executed Biomethane Purchase Agreement between FEI and the City of Surrey dated September 16, 2015 (Agreement) and for approval of a Monthly Facilities Fee as set forth in Schedule D of the Agreement (Application);
- B. By Orders G-186-15 and G-3-16, the Commission established a written public hearing process and regulatory timetable for the Application;
- C. On January 19, 2016, FEI filed with the Commission an Amending Agreement with the City of Surrey dated January 19, 2016;
- D. On February 29, 2016, by Order E-3-16 with Decision issued concurrently, the Commission approved the Agreement as amended by the Amending Agreement dated January 19, 2016 and the Monthly Facilities Fee.
- E. The following participants filed Participant Assistance/Cost Award (PACA) applications with the Commission with respect to their participation in the Application:
