ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On January 23, 2013, Corix Multi Utility Services Inc. (Corix) filed with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) an agreement to extend the term of its supply agreement for the period from April 1, 2013 to June 30, 2013, and this extension agreement was accepted by Order E-3-13 dated February 21, 2013;
- B. On May 11, 2013, Corix filed with the Commission an Annual Contracting Plan (ACP) for propane supply to Panorama Mountain Village (Panorama) for the period of July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014 Confidential Filing (the Filing);
- C. In the Filing, Corix sets out its tender process, Request for Quotation documents and price risk management strategy for securing competitive propane delivery service for Panorama;
- D. The Commission reviewed the submissions by Corix and determined that the filed Panorama propane ACP is appropriate and in the public interest.
